

Visiting

To answer your questions regarding visiting, as long term experienced breeders of over 15 years and have never had any infectious diseases and we intend to keep our dogs healthy for the years to come, Limiting visiting has become necessary. As you can imagine we can have up to 15 phone calls per day, with mostly the question can we come and visit your dogs, if I vet all potential enquiry's down to 5 suitable families this could be up to 15-25 people coming through my home everyday, not only the risk of infection but security must be considered.

Our answer is always the same, the health and welfare of our dogs/puppies is paramount to us, and by limiting visiting to the allocated 5 wks viewing day, and only to families that are on our waiting list and whom already have paid a deposit in good faith. We have a duty of care not only to those families but also to there puppies, who in some cases have already named their puppies albeit it by a photograph, they have already formed an attachment to their puppies, it is for this reason we only have families visiting that have reserved a puppy, and if at that time for any reason they are not happy with their puppy their deposit will be refunded without question this option is available on viewing day and not collection day.

We do hold a waiting list, it can be from 6-9 months, and we thank you for your patience.
